

Luvernes Safe Haven, Inc. Women's Domestic Violence Abuse Shelter Home Qualifications

To qualify applicants must first complete the application and be able to complete the checklist below. Qualifications outlines actions and processes that should be adhered to prior to the filling the application

- Applicants must live within the United States of America (including Washington D.C.), or any of its territories (American Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands) to be considered for abuse shelter residency.
- Applicant establishes a reason for needing residency at our domestic violence abuse shelter home services. **This can be answered within the application portal.**
- Applicant should be able to show proof of domestic violence police reports, pictures, texts, and or witness testimony to solidify the organization's documentation provision.

This information should be set aside and ready upon receiving a callback or email response after application submission. This will be asked within the application portal. If an applicant does not have tangible or digital proof, the applicant should be prepared to elaborate their absence of proof reasoning upon the initial callback.

- Applicants should not have any outstanding warrants or legal obligations that will not be adhered to upon moving into the abuse shelter home. **Applicants will be required to submit to a background check ONLY after the first application has been approved, a follow-up call been made, and the applicant gives permission for the background check. Submitting the application does**

not grant Luvernes Safe Haven, Inc. permission for a background check. It will only be performed with permission from the applicant after the initial callback.

- The application must be completed in full with no areas left blank in order for the application to be processed.

This is extremely important for paper application submissions. Applications will not be processed if any areas are left blank.

- To qualify for residency upon application approval, applicants must be able to move into the abuse shelter home no less than 14 days after initial approval.
- To qualify for residency applicants must agree to the terms and conditions discussed during the recorded initial first callback.
- To qualify for residency all prerequisite documentation should be submitted before residency entrance.
- All provided information must be submitted truthfully and accurately prior to residency entrance, and throughout the entire duration of residential occupancy. All information provided is meticulously verified for documentational and organizational purposes.
